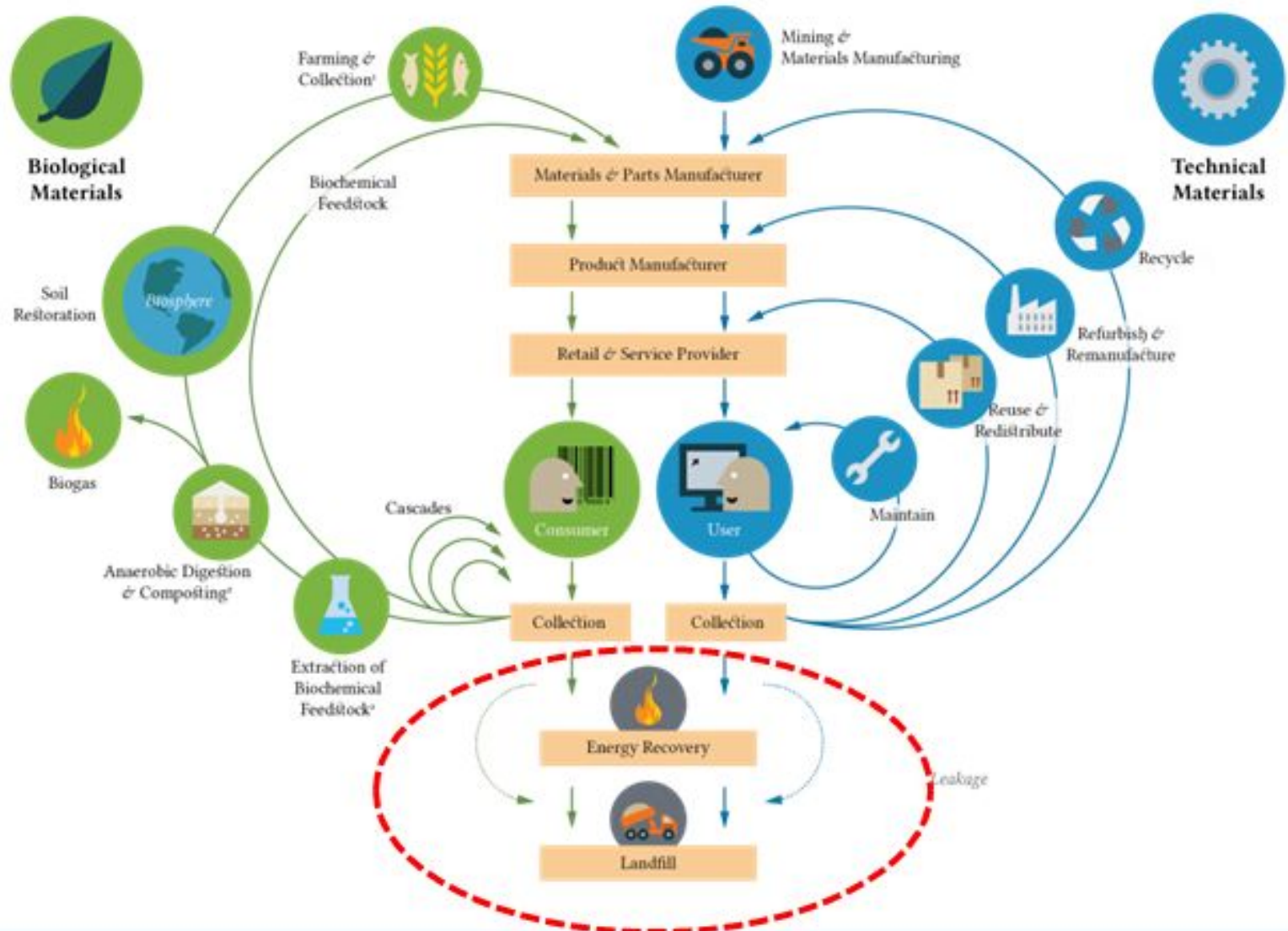

# Zero Waste Definition

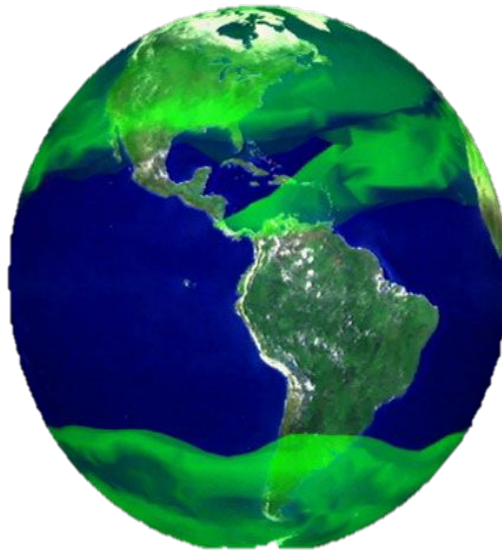
-
